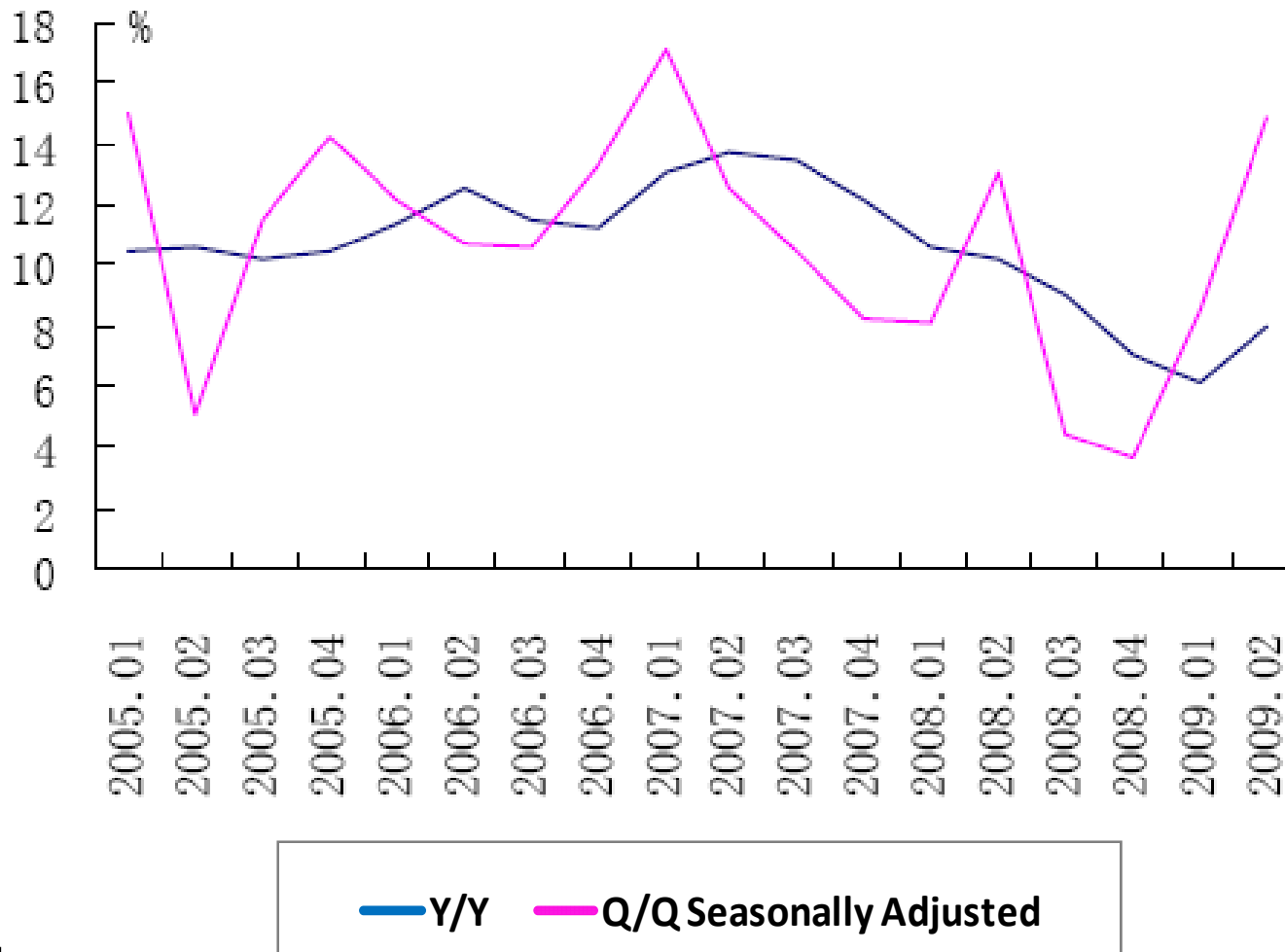

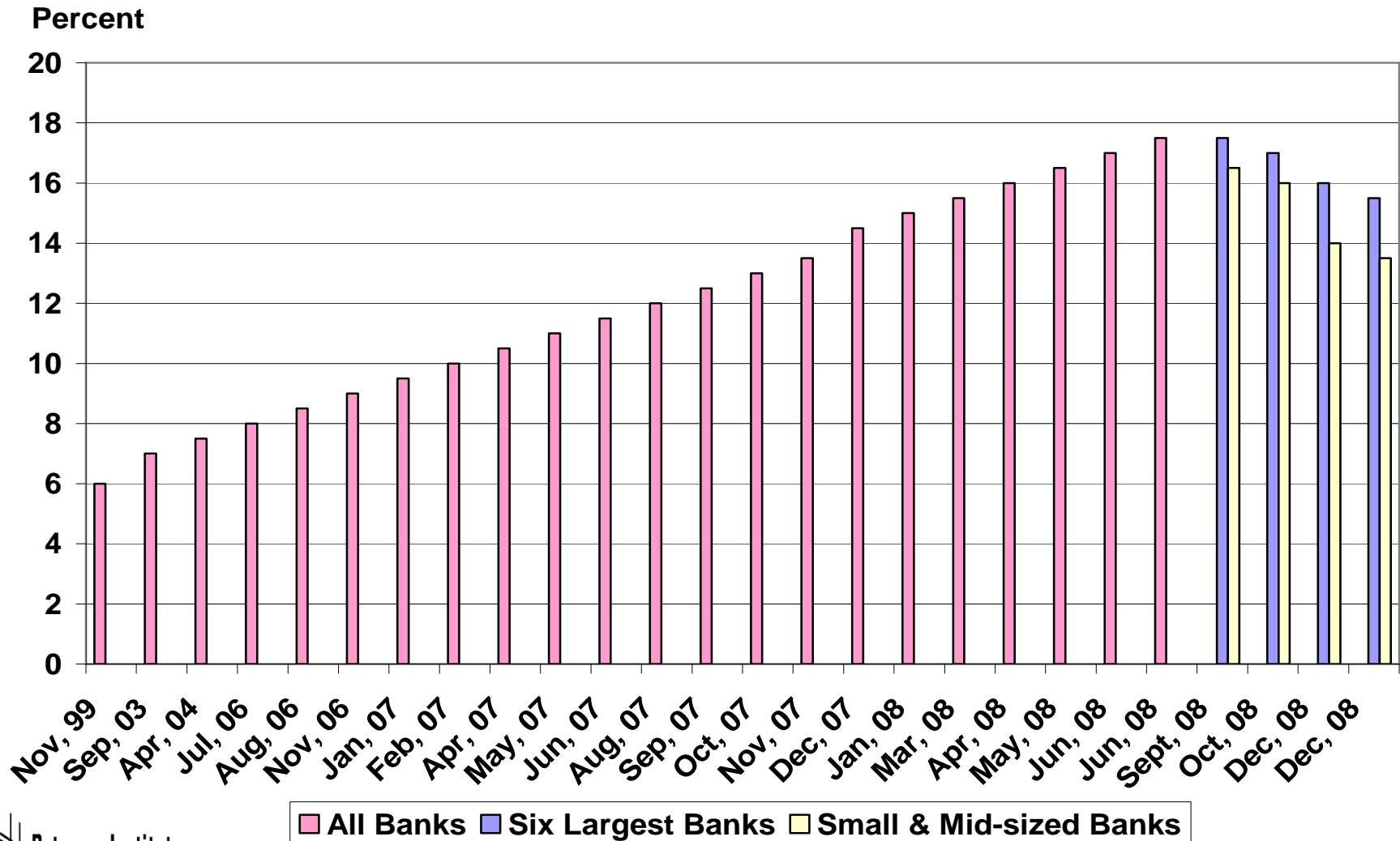

Quarterly GDP Growth

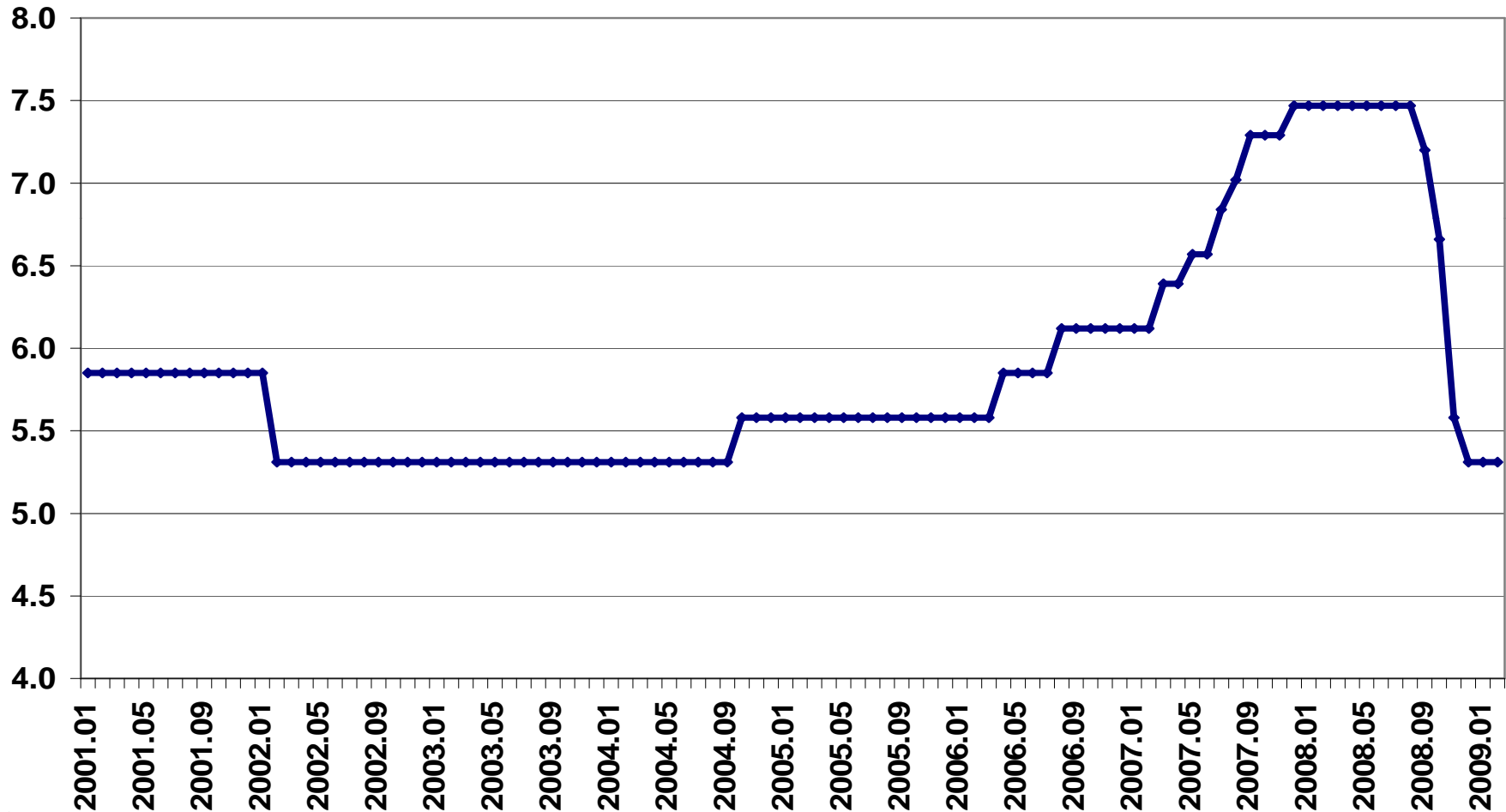


Required Reserve Ratio



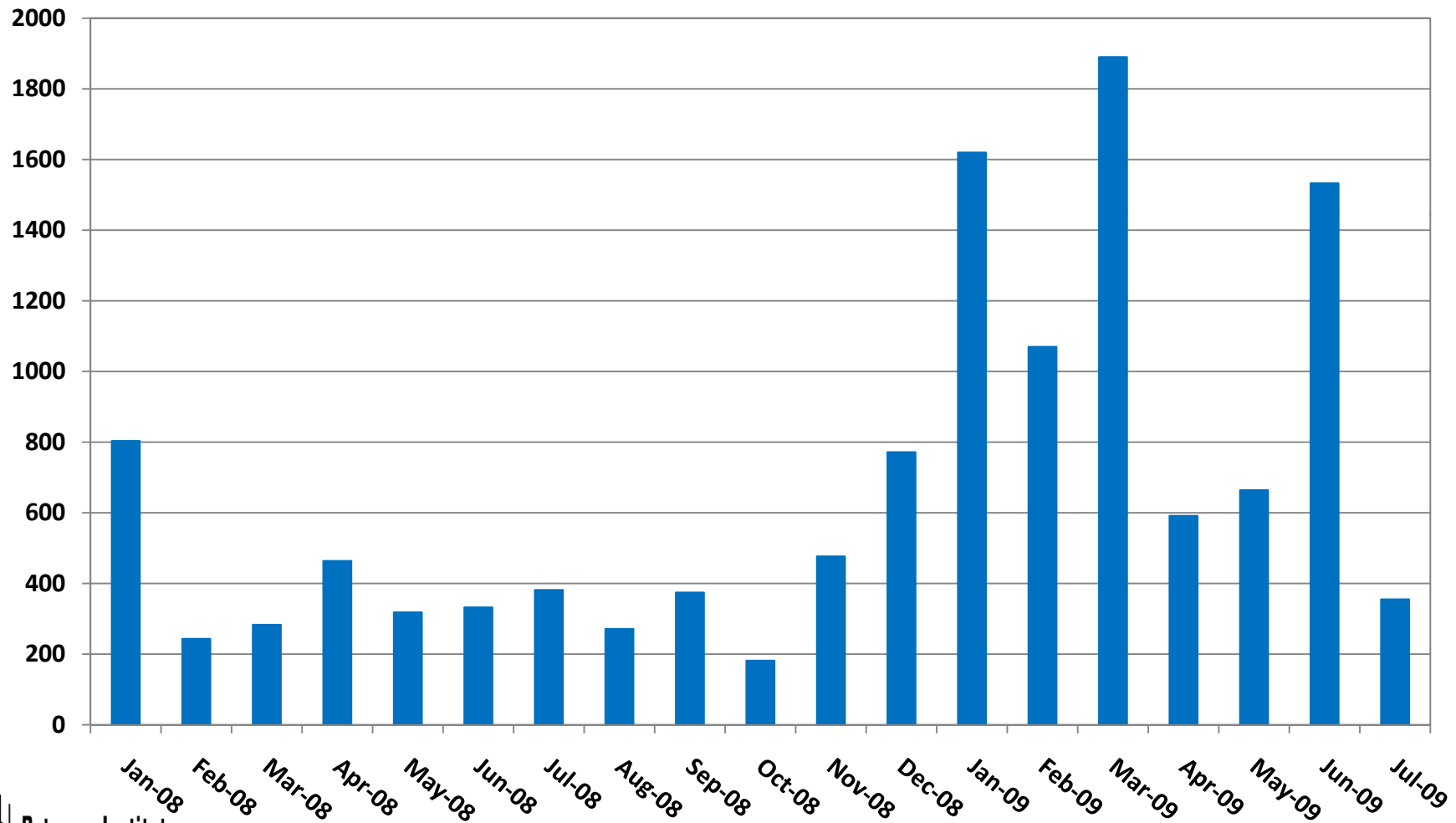
Benchmark One-year Lending Rate

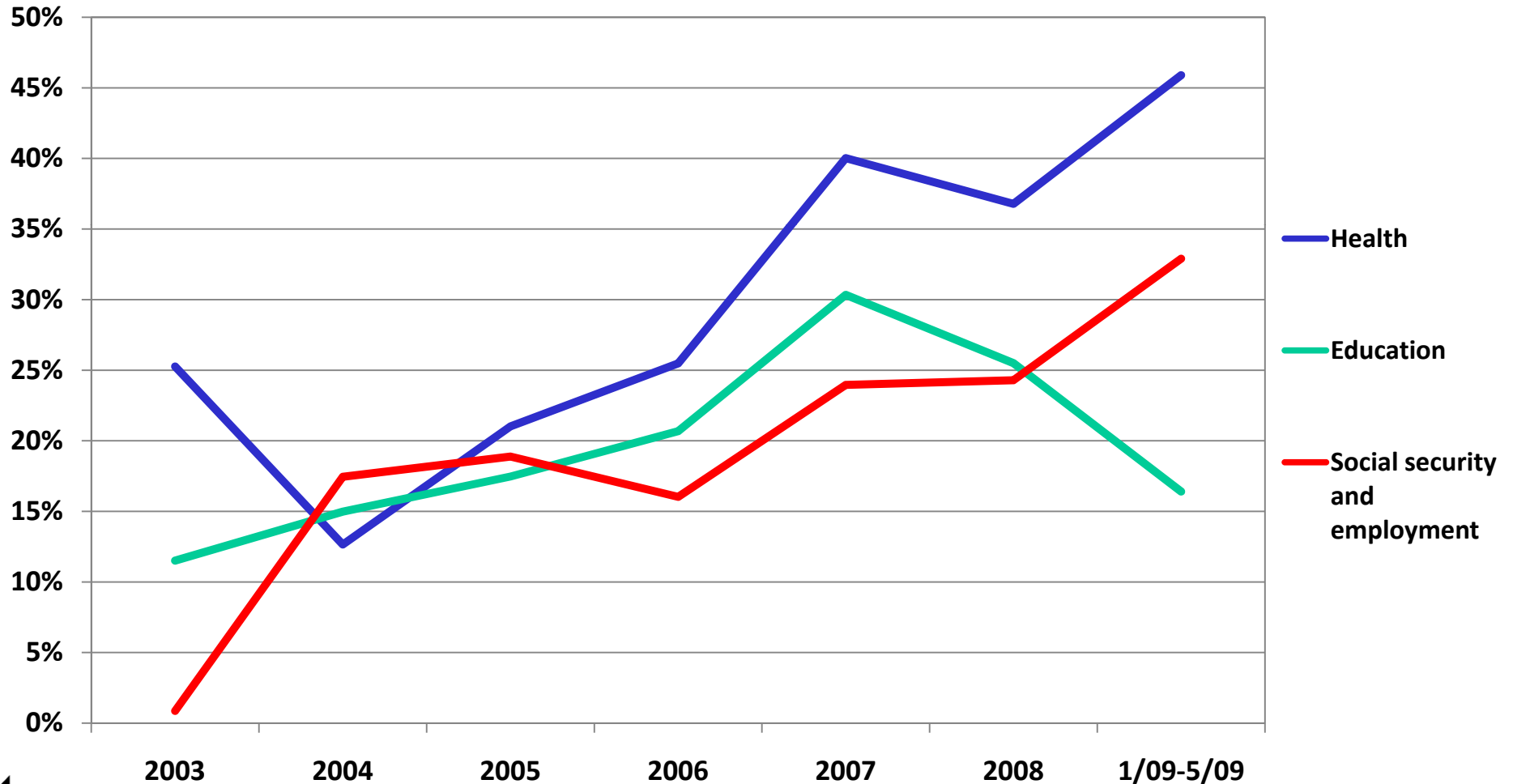


Monthly Bank Lending Growth

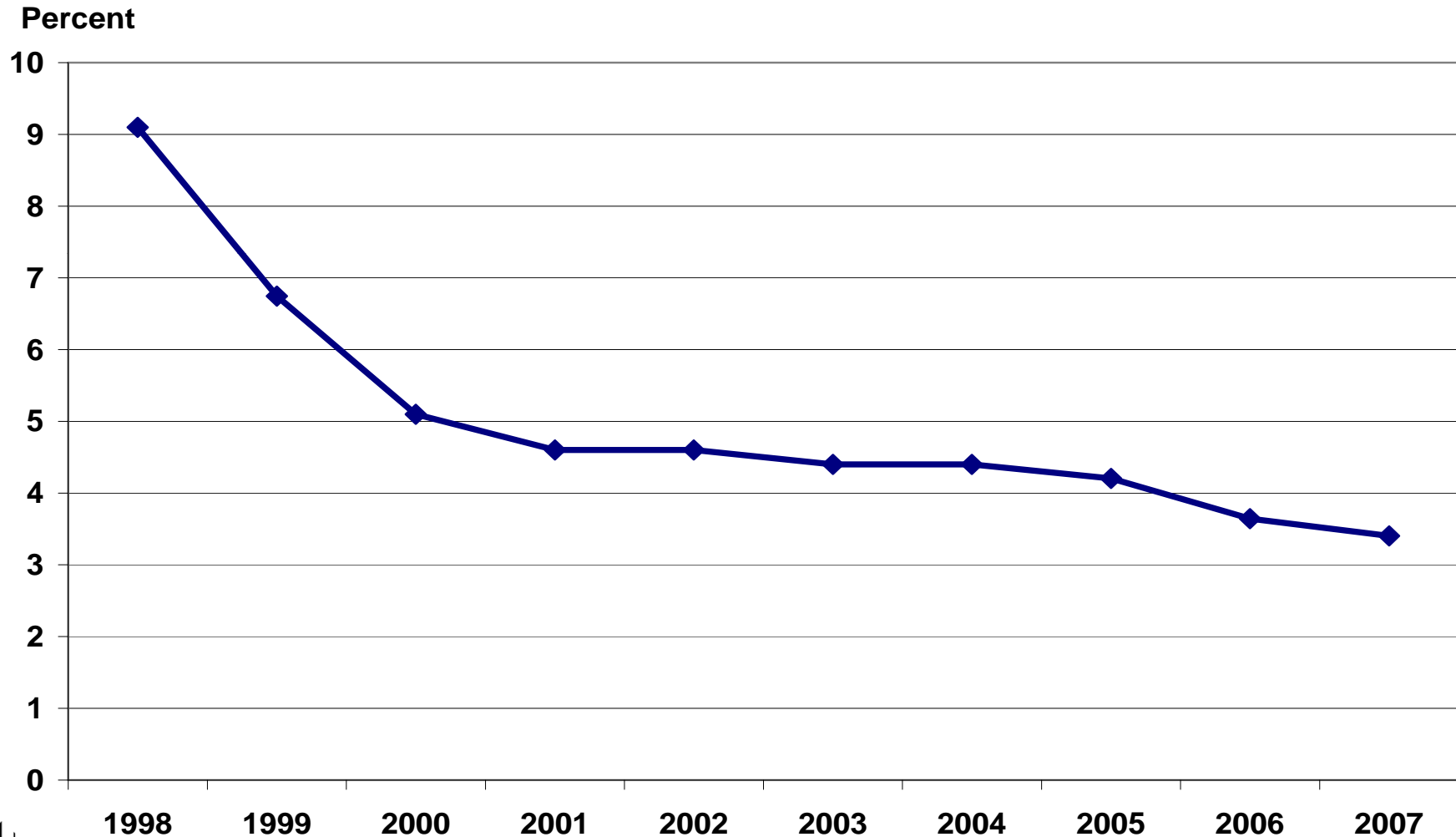

Government Social Expenditure Growth

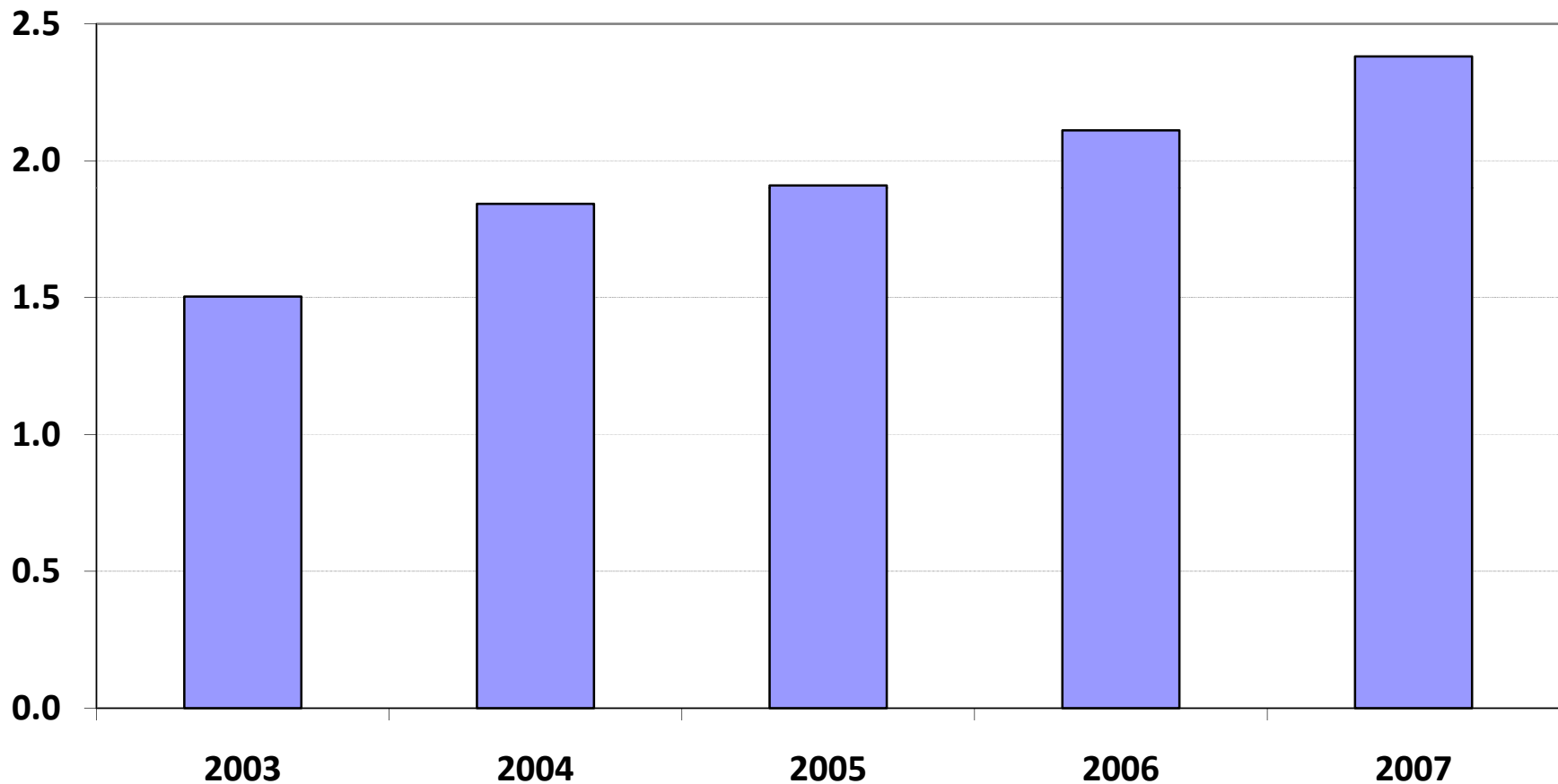


FDI as Percent of Fixed Asset Investment 1998 – 2007



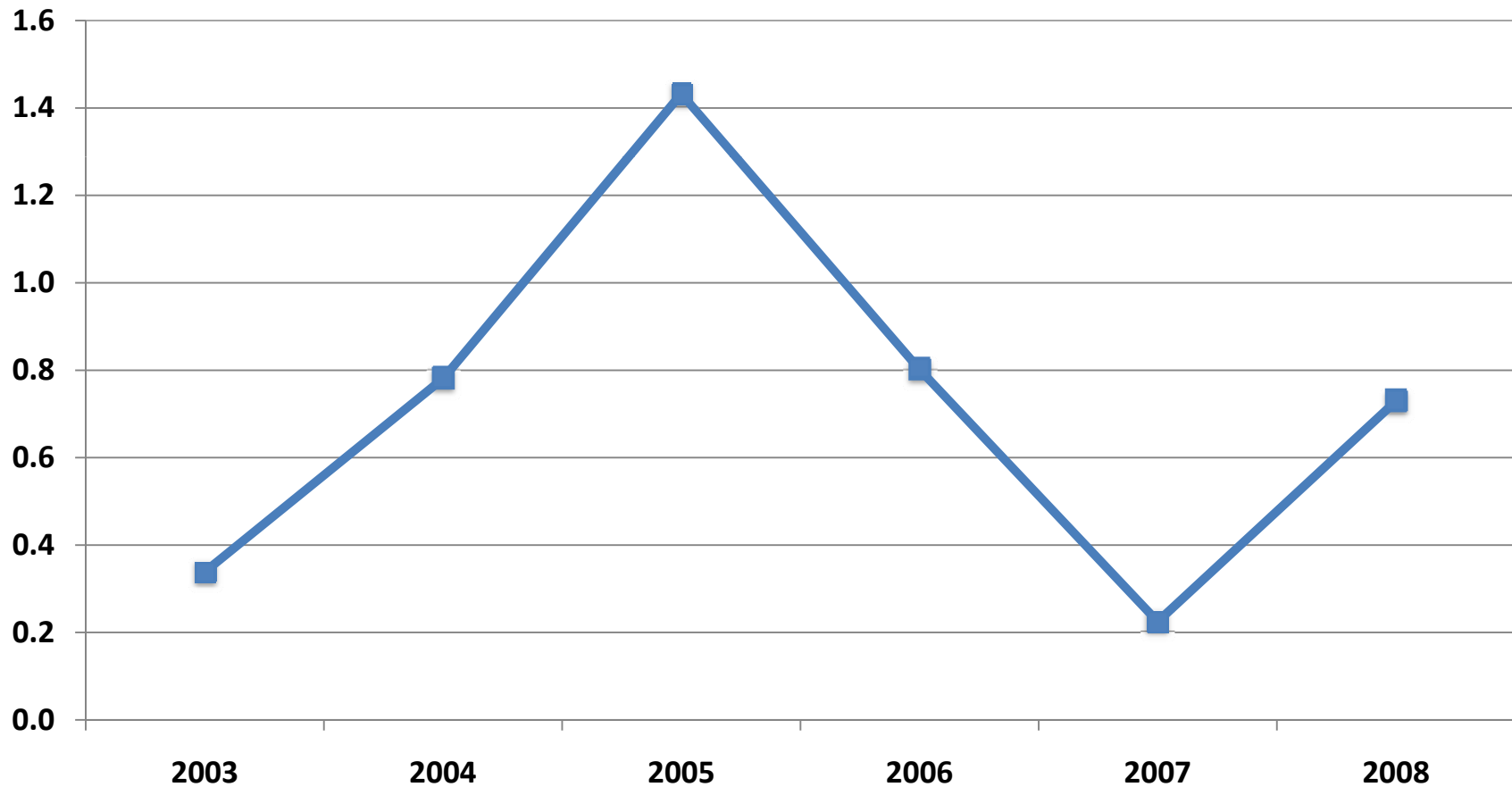
Foreign Banks' Share of Chinese Bank Assets

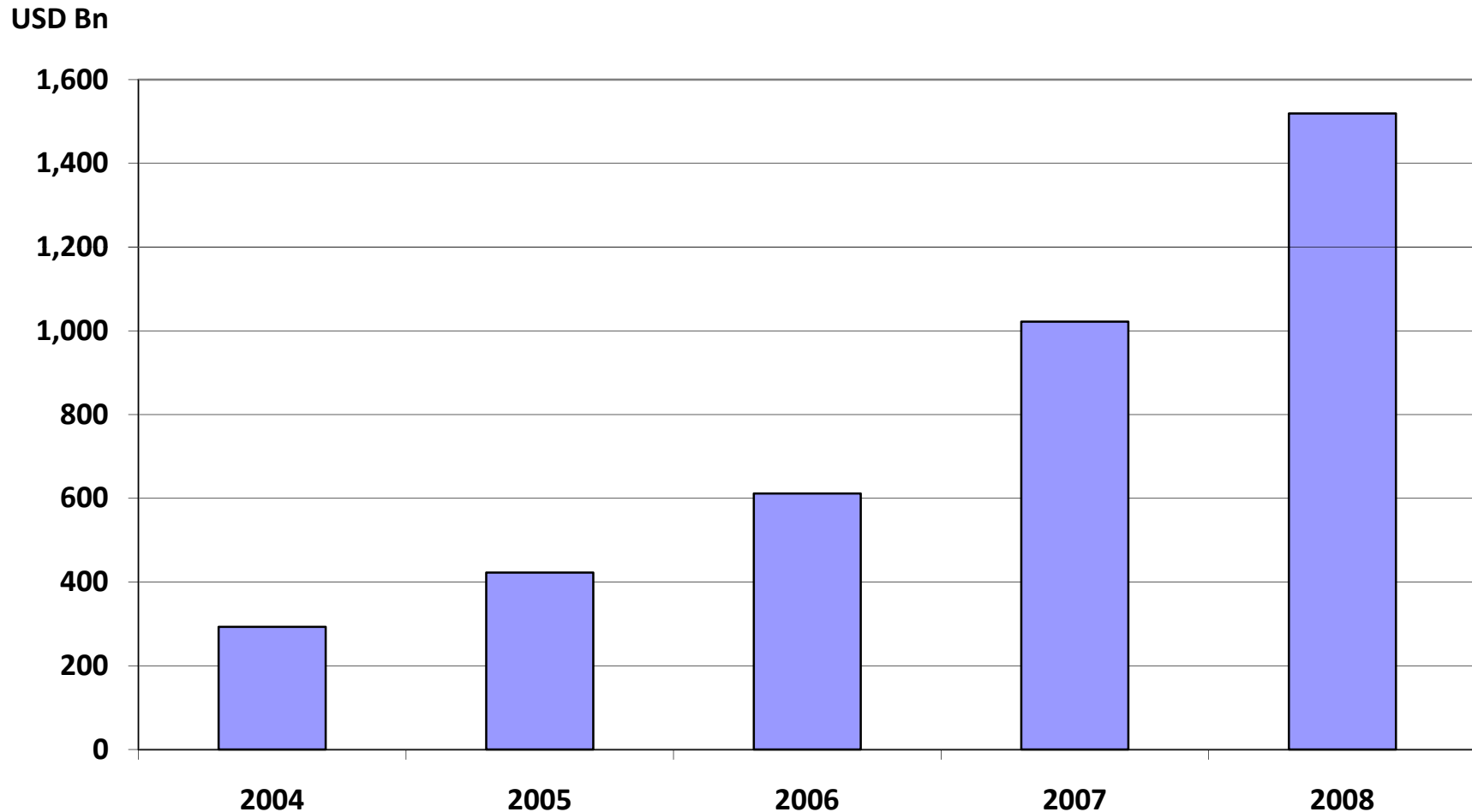


Foreign Portfolio Investment in China's Stock Market

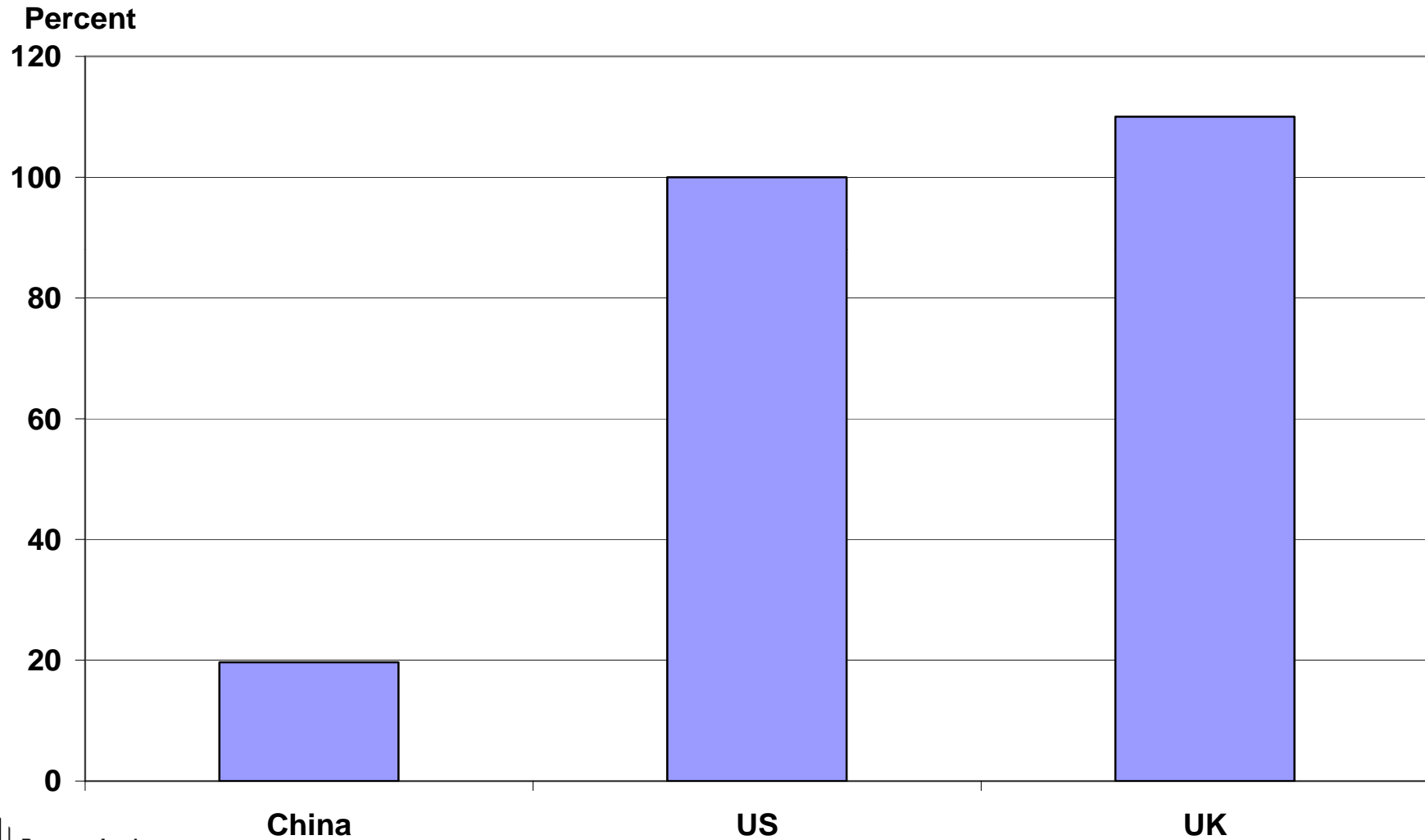

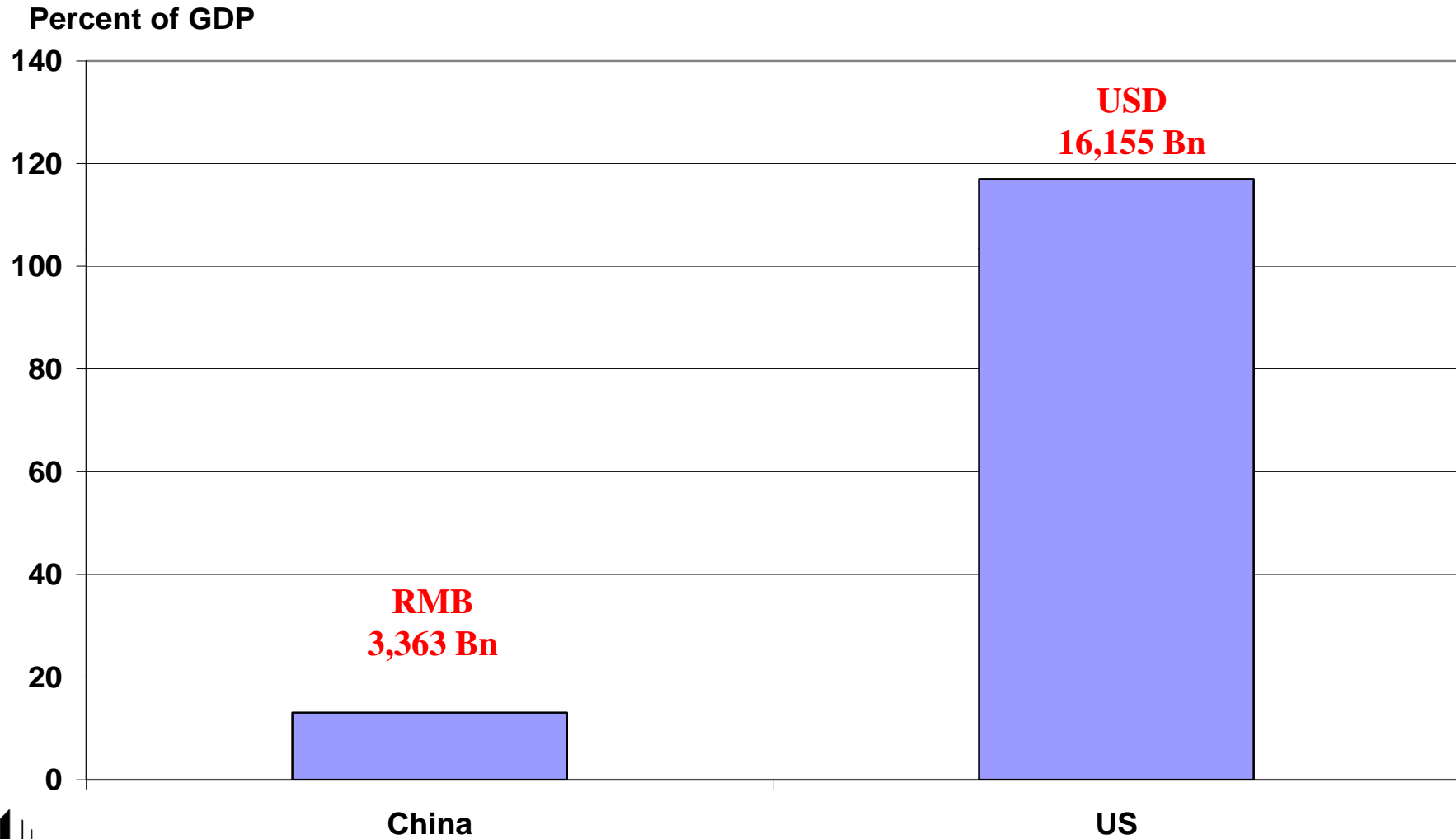
China's Net Foreign Investment Position, 2004-2008



Household Debt as Percent of GDP, 2007

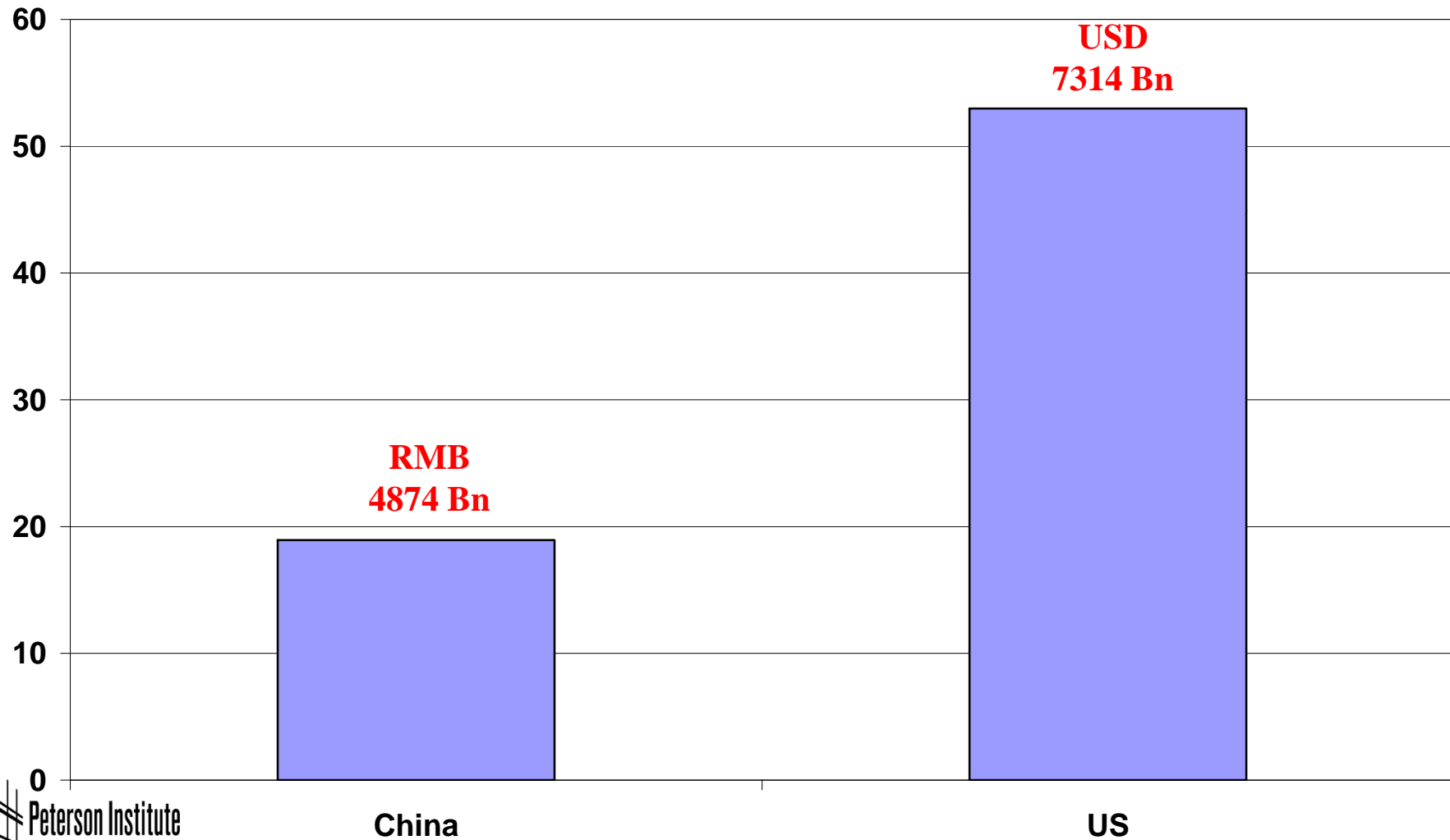


Financial Sector Debt 2007

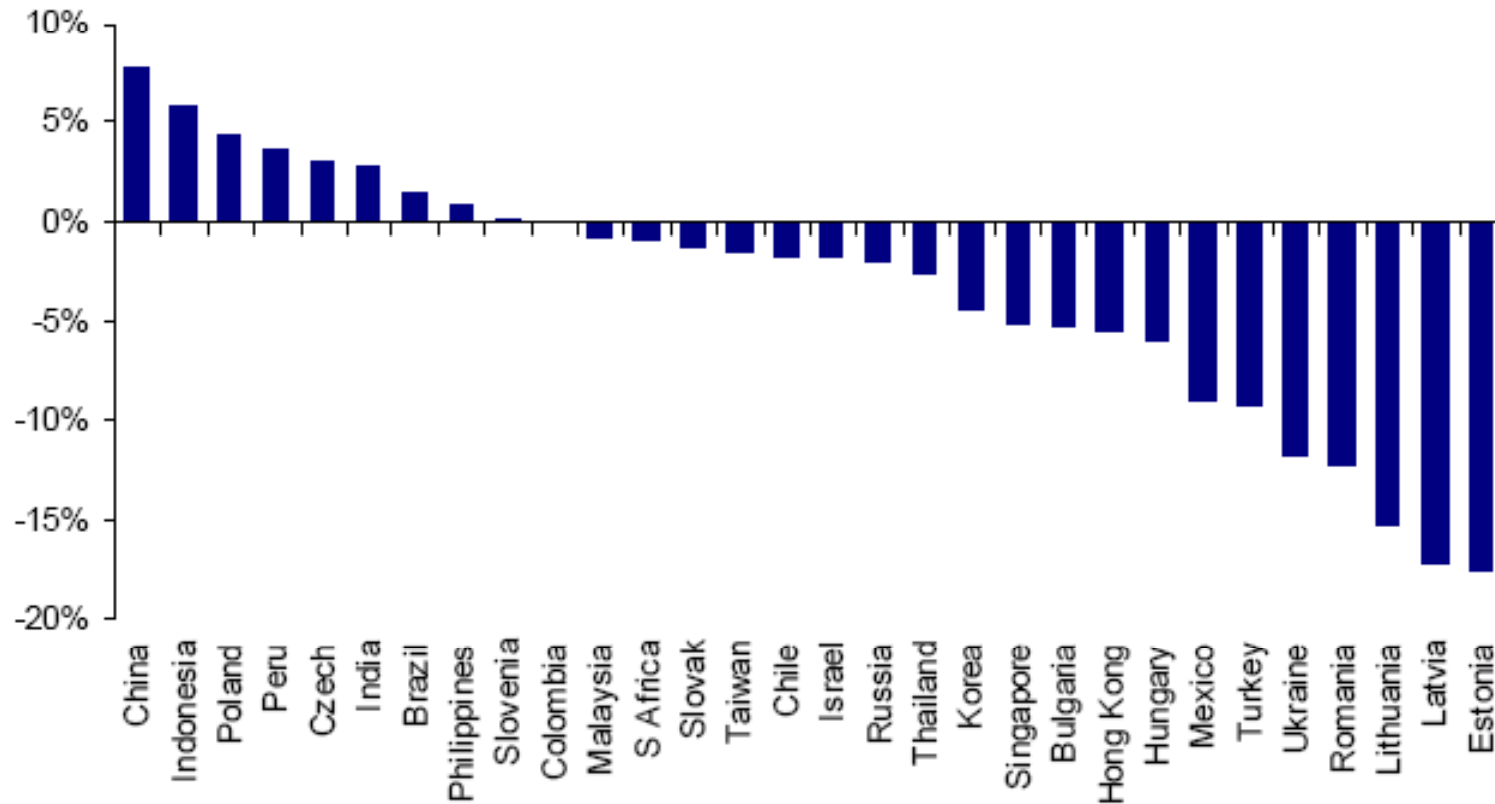


Public Debt 2007

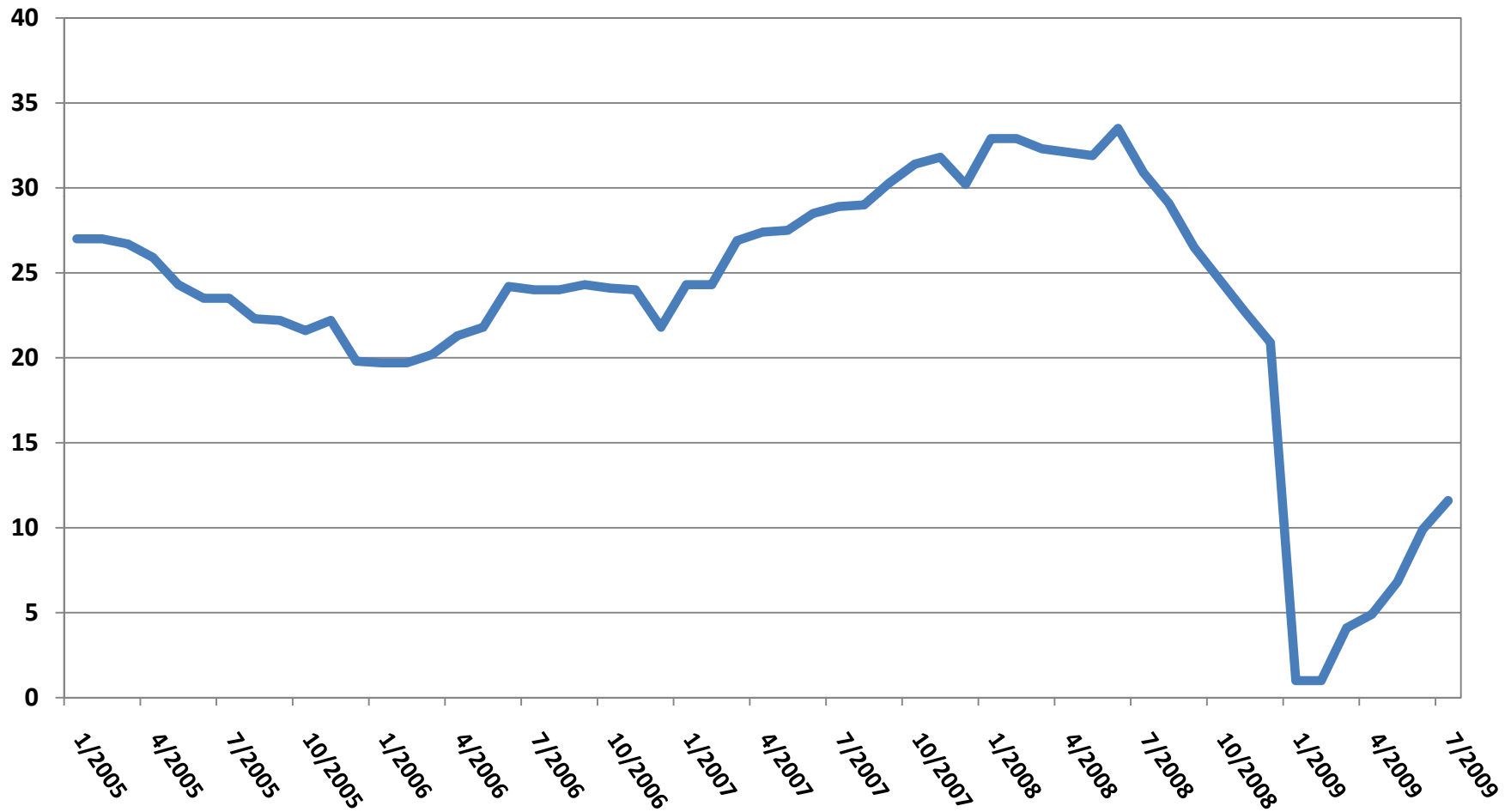
Real Household Consumption Growth, Q1 2009



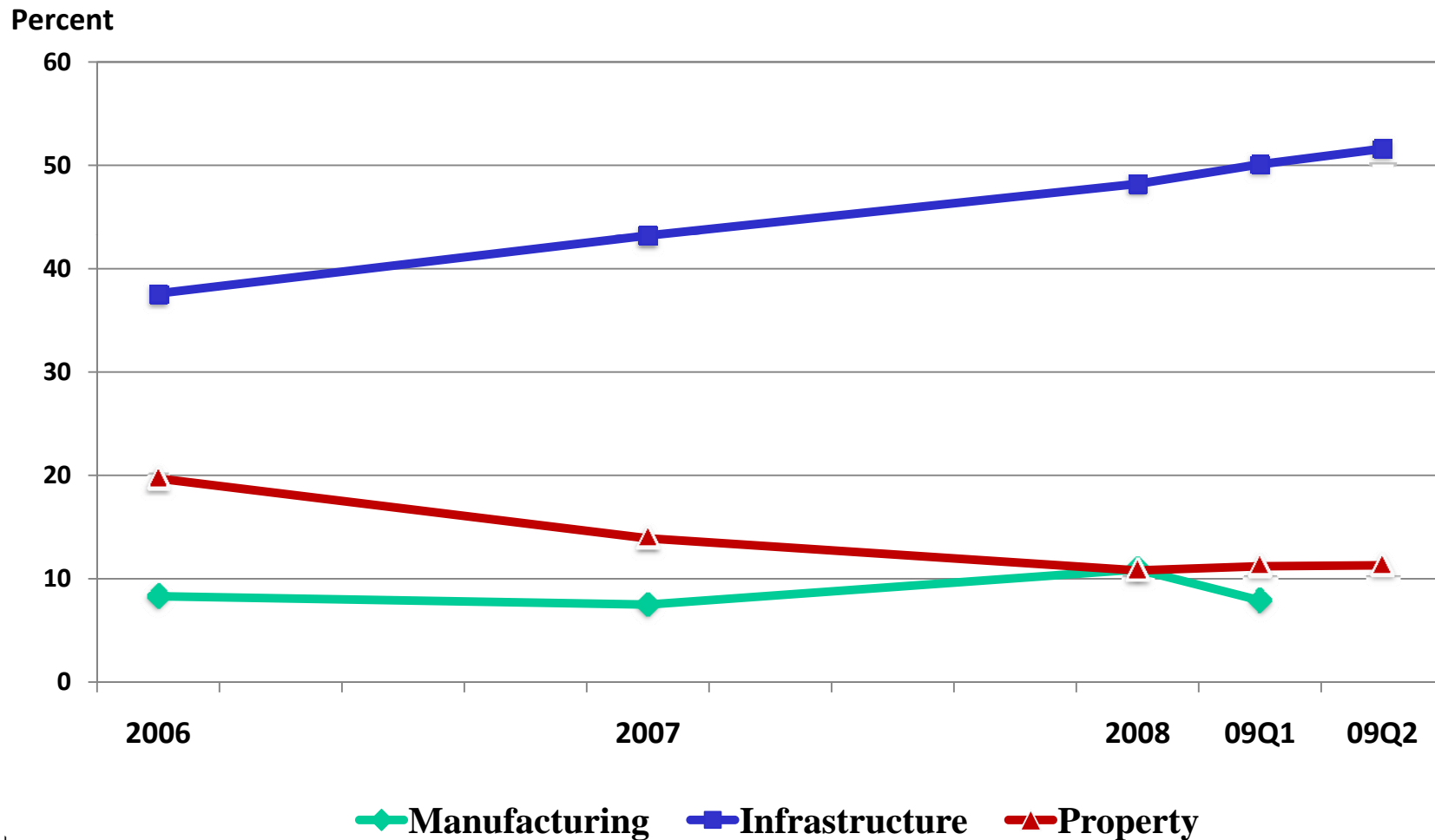

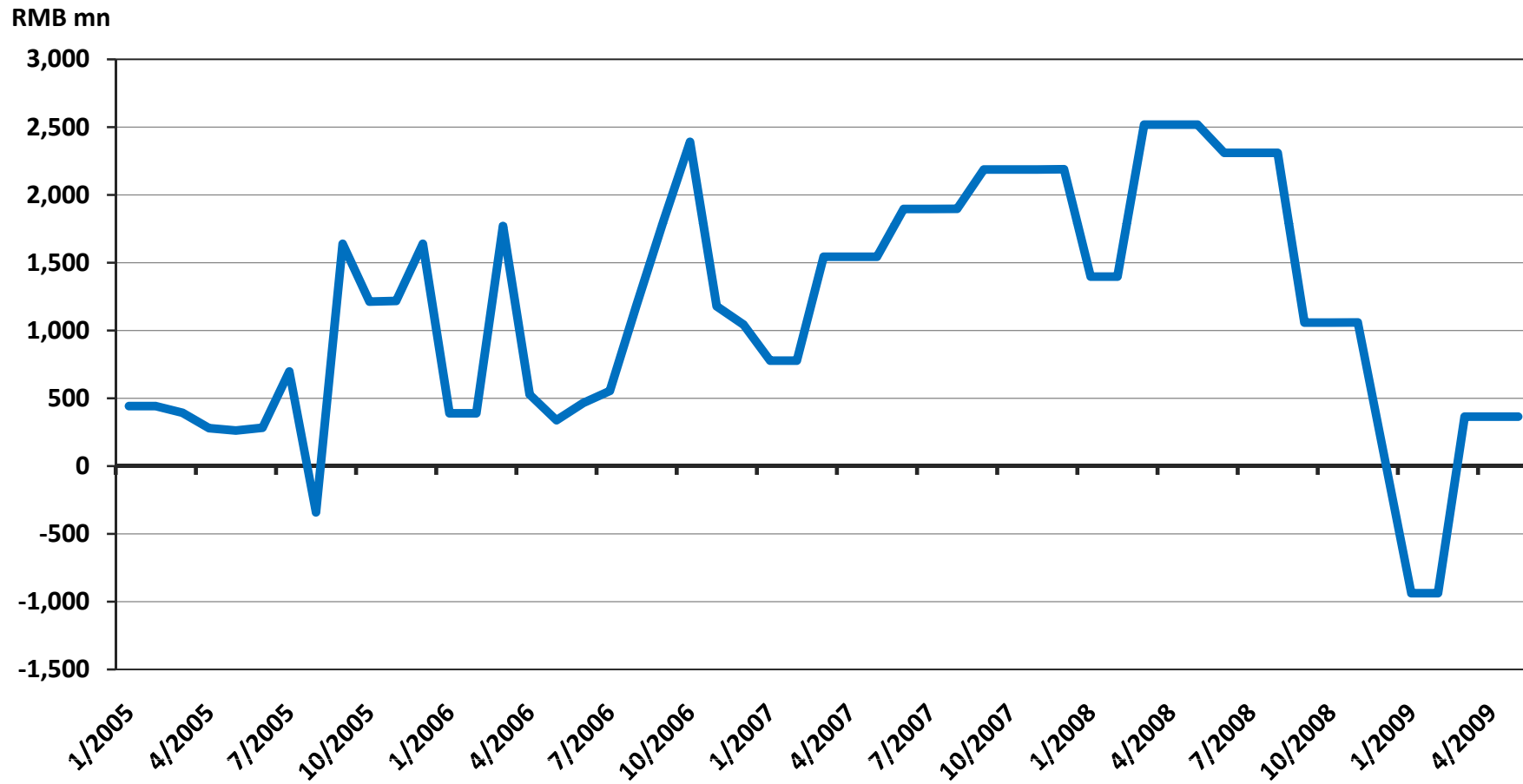

Composition of New Medium and Long-Term Loans, 2006 - 2009Q2

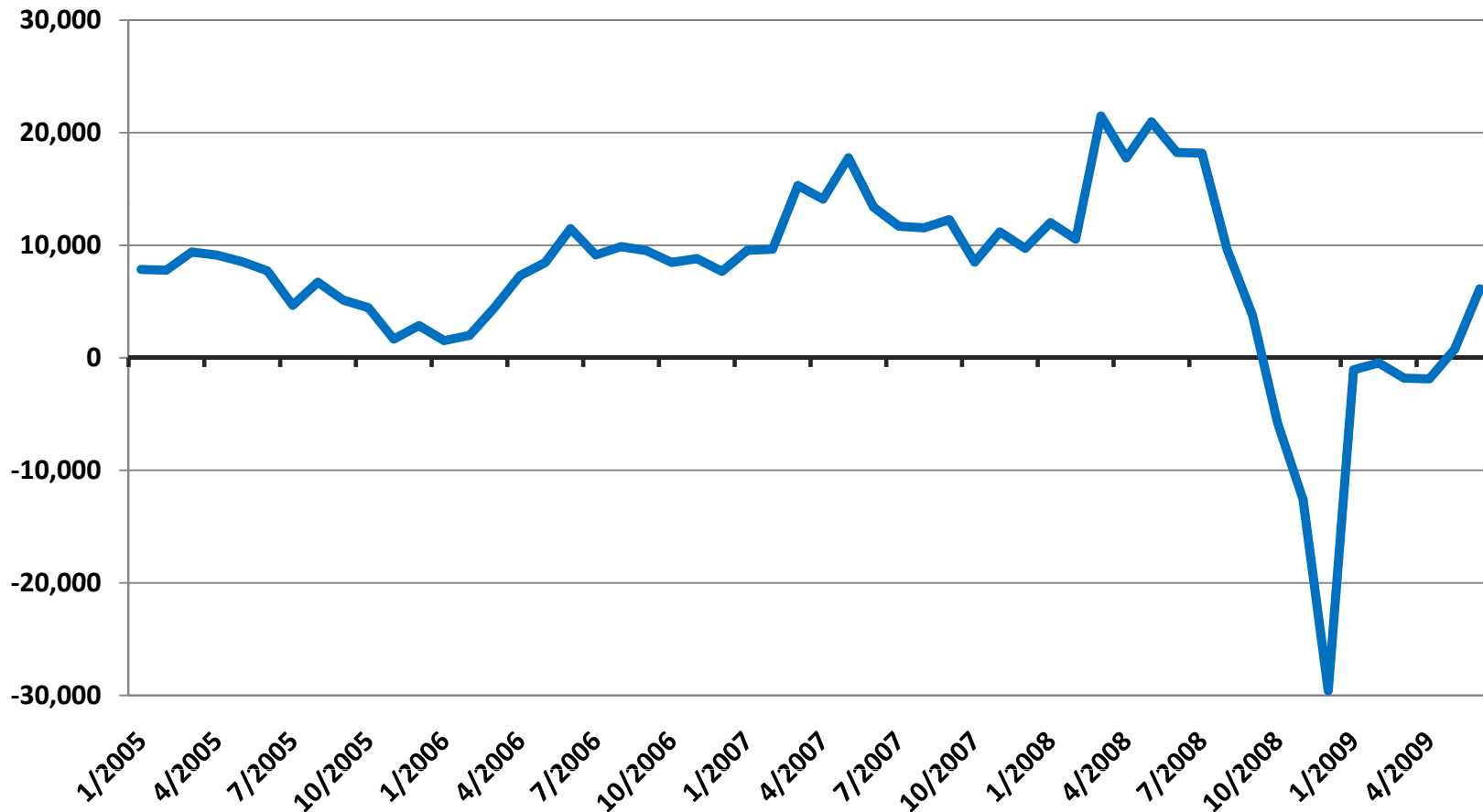


Electronic Appliances, Monthly Profits

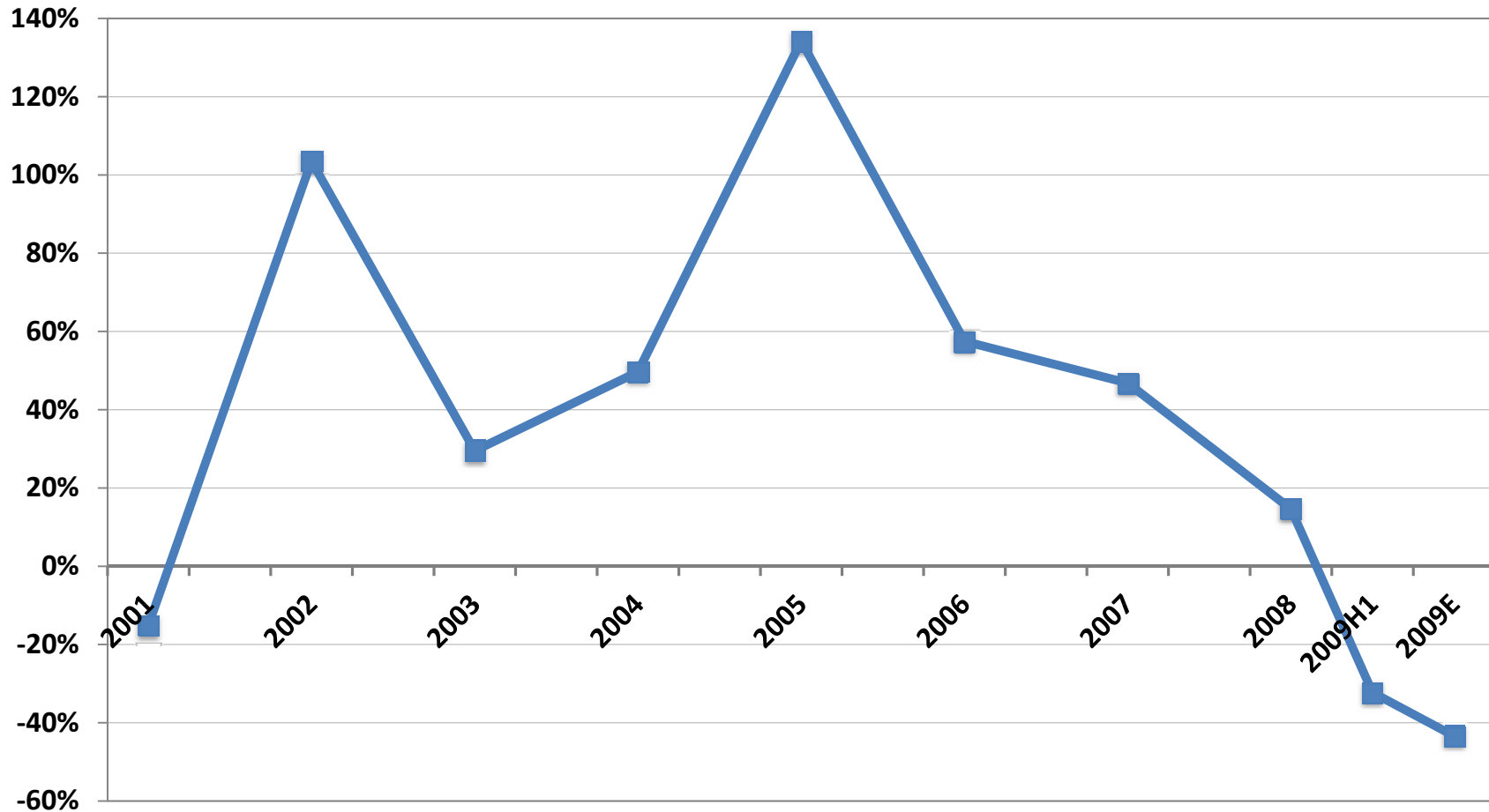


Steel Industry, Monthly Profits
